DMV LEARNER'S PERMIT TEST

The DMV Learner's Permit Test will be given in the Driver Education classroom (Building 15) at no cost Friday March 2 at 9 AM to the first 20 students who preregister at vadmvexam.com. This is available only to VHS students who are at least 15 years and 6 months old on the test date. Students who are attempting the test for the 3rd time are ineligible to take it at school and must take it at DMV. Students should study the DMV Driver's Manual prior to the test. On test day students MUST bring a charged laptop, picture ID, & turn in the completed and signed DTS 41 consent form. This consent form is available online, in the main office, or from Coach Sorbello or Mrs. Hiort.
