### **SOL WRITING TEST**

This week, students enrolled in English 10 will take the SOL Writing Test. The test is given in two parts: multiple choice and essay. The test will be given on two days: Tuesday and Thursday. ### **DMV LEARNER'S PERMIT TEST**

The DMV Learner's Permit Test will be given in the Driver Education classroom (Building 15) at no cost Friday March 23 at 9 AM to the first 20 students who preregister at [vadmvexam.com](http://vadmvexam.com). This is available only to VHS students who are at least 15 years and 6 months old on the test date. Students who are attempting the test for the 3<sup>rd</sup> time are ineligible to take it at school and must take it at DMV. Students should study the DMV Driver's Manual prior to the test. On test day students MUST bring a charged laptop, photo ID, & turn in the completed and signed DTS
