SOL Testing this Week

We are giving part 2 of the SOL writing test this week. It was rescheduled due to the snow day last week. There are several important reminders I need to share with you.

First – the testing will impact our schedule this week. On Tuesday, 3rd period will run from 9 AM- 12:15 PM.

If your student is testing, he/she will be REQUIRED to give the testing proctor his/her phone. If you or your student are not comfortable with this, then please leave the phone at home. It is STATE testing procedure that we secure all cell phones before testing begins. If your student's phone causes a disruption to the testing environment, depending on the severity of the disruption, there may be severe school, county, and even state consequences.

If your student is testing, be sure he/she has a fully-charged laptop ready to go on Tuesday. Additionally, due to the fact that we are testing ALL 10th graders at the same time, your student may not have his/her English teacher as the testing proctor. We expect students to be cooperative no matter who the testing proctor is.

During the testing block, the walkways must remain clear. Testing will be occurring in a variety of places on campus. Teachers in non-testing rooms will most likely build in a break for students to use the restroom. Students who fail to follow directions, either in the testing room or during the testing time, will be sent home immediately.
