DMV LEARNER'S PERMIT TEST

The DMV Learner's Permit Test will be given in the Driver Education classroom (Building 15) at no cost Friday, November 3 at 9 AM to the first 20 students who pre-register online at vadmvexam.com. This is available only to VHS students who are at least 15 years and 6 months old on the test date. Students who are attempting the test for the 3rd time are ineligible to take it at school and must take it at DMV. Students should study the DMV Driver's Manual and MUST bring a charged laptop on test day. Also, students must bring picture ID on the test day & turn in the completed and signed DTS 41 consent form. This consent form is available in the main office or from Coach Sorbello or Mrs. Hiort.
